FAQ

HOW DO I DONATE?

IS IT TAX DEDUCTIBLE?

Yes! The Baxter County Sheriff's Foundation has been approved as a non profit 501c3 corporation. This means that all private donations are tax deductible for the donor. The Foundation will issue an official receipt to all donors for tax purposes.

MAY I DONATE PROPERTY OR LEAVE PROPERTY IN MY ESTATE?

Yes, the Sheriff's Foundation may accept donations of real property or personal property that may be suitable for use by the Sheriff's Office or its employees. Examples include high quality exercise equipment and land or homes that can be sold. You may also designate that a portion of your

Potential donations of real property will be reviewed by the Foundation's Board of Directors before acceptance of real property is decided upon.
